BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 102

N O T I C E

Borough Ordinance No. 102 regulating the burning of paper rubbish or other waste material, strictly prohibits such action within the borough at any time except between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. or 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M. on any week day.

Any fire started during these hours must be extinguished when said burning period is over. Any violator of the ordinance is subject to a fine of five (\$5.00) to twenty five (\$25.00) dollars imprisonment or from one (1) to five (5) days.

TAKE COVER SIGNAL

Wailing tone or short blasts for 3 minutes on sirens, whistles, horns, or similar devices

WHAT TO DO

At Home: Get into your home shelter immediately. If you have none, shut all outside doors and windows and take cover in the basement or a first room.

At School: Turn off all lights, close all windows, and pull the blinds. Take cover against the walls that are perpendicular to the wall with the windows in. Keep your face towards the wall. this will minimize the chance of you being struck by flying glass.

Above all,
REMAIN SILENT

Outdoors: Seek the best available cover.

Stay put until you get word to come out.

Important: If you see a bright flash of light, take cover instantly.

ALERT SIGNAL

A steady blast of 3 to 5 minutes on sirens, whistles, horns, or similar devices.

WHAT TO DO

Do not use the telephone.

Turn your AM radio to a Conelrad station(640 or 1240)

Don't become panicky if your radio is silent for a short time.

This is necessary to switch to emergency broadcasting frequencies. Know your local civil defense emergency plans. Obey police and civil defense instruction.
